Ripe, rounded and generous, a warm plum juice-flavored wine. There is power and concentration. It is a very complete, ageworthy wine, although accessible now.

HENRY FESSY *Morgon 2009*

A really ripe wine, rich and with generous feel to it. The sweet cherry fruit is powered with plum juice, dense tannins and structure. A wine for aging.

HENRY FESSY *Fleurie 2009*

A richly aromatic wine, with swathes of sweet fruit, ripe tannins and a juicy, jammy feel. This is so generous, open, welcoming. There is structure as well, cushioned by the sweet fruits.

HENRY FESSY *Moulin-à-Vent 2010*

A very structured wine, as befits this normally powerful cru. It is packed with dark tannins and minerality. The wine is angular, and you can taste the granite and schist soil. This edge of austerity is balanced by delicious fruit.
