## 88 Henry Fessy Côte de Brouilly 2010

Well-knit and subtle, this fresh red offers brambly black and red fruit, with plum and mineral notes. Light tannins show on the finish. Drink now through 2017.



## 88 Henry Fessy Fleurie 2010

Fresh and tangy, with pure flavors of cherry, white raspberry and ripe plum. Balanced, offering a clean, spice-tinged finish. Drink now through 2015.

## 88 Henry Fessy Régnié Château des Reysiers 2010

Fresh and tangy, delivering black currant, dried cranberry and wild strawberry fruit mixed with hints of pencil shavings and spice. Well-balanced, ending with a lightly chewy finish. Drink now through 2017.



## 88 Henry Fessy Moulin-à-Vent 2010

Light-bodied and fresh, with raspberry, red currant, licorice, dried thyme and spice notes, showing just a hint of hoisin sauce and ending with a clean finish. Drink now through 2018.
