

## Meeting new faces & tasting new wines at Louis Latour Agencies

Henry Fessy, Louis Latour's estate in Beaujolais, was largely showing the 2018 vintage which is a return to the lighter, slightly more crisp style of Bojo after the rich and slightly more powerful 2015, 2017 and, soon to come 2019 vintages. Reminders again of just how delicious **Beaujolais Blanc 2018** can be and then tastes of the usual suspects – all the Beaujolais crus apart from Chiroubles.

There was one new wine simply called **Beaujolais 2018** which was terrific, a non-intervention, cloudy red which was really wild and made for early drinking (no added sulphur, yeasts and no filtration). Winemaker Laurent Chevalier explained that he concentrated on Beaujolais Nouveau stylistically which he sold 1000 as such with another 1000 bottles kept as a 'natural' Beaujolais. More experiments please Laurent! This is a terrific stuff and is an interesting direction for this always-reliable domaine.
