This Beaujolais Villages comes from several villages located in the northern part of the region. A large proportion of this blend comes from our stunning old-vine parcel planted on a 45° sloped hillside. These wines combine finesse, flavor and roundness and are perfect for immediate enjoyment. Winemaking

Traditional vinification with controlled temperature.

Tasting note

Our Beaujolais-Villages reveals a deep ruby red colour. The nose is full of red fruits, lightly spicy. In the mouth, the structure is round and supple with fresh fruits flavours. The tanins are silky, pleasant and gourmet wine.

Suggested food pairings

Wild game, meat dishes with sauces, roasts, charcuterie and cheese.
